Did you know that disposing of grass clippings and leaf litter down the storm drain is considered an “Illicit Discharge” in Prince William County?

Prince William staff has the legal responsibility to control discharges and impose fines against anyone who knowingly allows or causes pollutants to enter the storm drain system via the Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Program (IDDE).
